## **TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE ON-STREET PARKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

Dear Breckenridge Business Owner, Citizen or Guest:

The Breckenridge Parking Department received your request for vehicles to park on the street for your upcoming special event. We appreciate you notifying us and we will be able to grant permission for on-street parking under the following conditions:

- All vehicles must park on one side of the street and face the same direction.
- No parking within five feet of a public or private driveway.
- No parking within fifteen feet of a fire hydrant.
- No parking within twenty feet of a crosswalk.
- No parking on sidewalks, or blocking of intersections.
- No parking on a bridge or other elevated structure.
- No parking on any town streets from 2:00 a.m. – 6:00 a.m., unless otherwise approved in this agreement by a Community Service Officer.

Please keep in mind, parking on Town streets is normally prohibited. In order for the Town to make an exception to the parking ordinance, we need strict compliance with the above regulations from all your guests. Violations could result in a vehicle being ticketed or towed, at the owner's expense.
